**AD2-1 Notice**

This Addendum No. 2, dated April 4, 2017, to the Request for Proposals: Wireless LAN, supersedes all contrary and conflicting information in the above-mentioned instructions, specifications, and contract documents which are hereby supplemented or revised in certain particulars as follows:

**AD2-2 General Information**

The District submits this Addendum to provide clarification on District specifications.

**AD2-3 Instructions**

Proposer shall initial the bottom of this Addendum No. 2, and include it with his/her sealed proposal.

**Cabling**

The successful respondent shall furnish and install Belden CAT 6 cable as required for this project.

The CAT 6 cables shall be manufactured by Belden. No other manufacturer or substitutes shall be acceptable. The cables shall be installed by a Belden Certified technician.

All cables shall be new, unused and of current design and manufacture. The district currently uses Belden cable part number 2412 with a blue jacket.

**Testing**

The District requires that all cables are tested for "end to end attenuation".

Any defect in the cabling systems installed by respondent, including, but not limited to, cable and connectors shall be repaired or replaced by the successful respondent at no additional cost to the District.

The successful respondent shall be responsible for providing all the required test equipment used to conduct acceptance tests.

The District reserves the right to be present during any or all testing. The successful respondent shall notify the District twenty-four (24) hours in advance of any planned testing. Testing performed without the District's knowledge and approval will be rejected.

Test results must be provided to the District's Project Manager prior to project acceptance.

### **Test Results**

The successful respondent shall submit test results in electronic format. Handwritten test reports are unacceptable.

All test results must clearly indicate the test operator name, the manufacturer, model and serial number of each test instrument, along with software and firmware versions used to perform tests.

- Electronic results shall be submitted on CD, DVD or USB memory stick. The respondent must include any software required to view test results unless results are in non-proprietary format (example: PDF). It is the respondent's responsibility to confirm that the District is able to review and print electronic test results. The District requires three (3) copies of the electronic test results.

### **Labeling**

The District requires that each cable have a unique identifier. This identifier shall be permanently affixed to each device. The labels shall be generated with an appropriate labeling device. Hand written labels are unacceptable and will be rejected. Labels shall be printed in clearly legible font and resistant to heat & moisture.

Printed Labels shall be compliant with ANSI/TIA/EIA 606A standards.
