

ORDINANCE NO. 18/19-P-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE ROCK RIVER WATER RECLAMATION DISTRICT, WINNEBAGO COUNTY,
ILLINOIS, ASCERTAINING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES FOR LABORERS, MECHANICS,
AND WORKMEN EMPLOYED ON PUBLIC WORKS OF SAID DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted “An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, county, city, or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being 820 ILCS 130/0.01 through 12; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Rock River Water Reclamation District investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics, and other workmen in the locality of said Sanitary District employed in performing construction of public works, for said Sanitary District. This includes any maintenance, repair, assembly, or disassembly work performed on site whether the item is owned, leased, or rented;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Rock River Water Reclamation District:

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by “An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, county, city, or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics, and other workmen engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of this sanitary district is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in Winnebago County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of May 24, 2018, said rates being the latest rates determined by the Illinois Department of Labor, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act. If the prevailing rate of wages for construction work is revised by the Department of Labor subsequent to the effective date of the Ordinance, the revised rates shall apply to all contracts for public works being executed at the time of such revision or executed subsequent to such revision.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3: The Clerk of the Rock River Water Reclamation District shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Rock River Water Reclamation District this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

SECTION 4: The Clerk of the Rock River Water Reclamation District shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workmen whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5: The Clerk of the Rock River Water Reclamation District shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6: The Clerk of the Rock River Water Reclamation District shall cause a notice to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area that the determination of prevailing wages has been made. Said notice shall conform substantially to the notice attached hereto. Such publication shall constitute notice that this is the determination of the Rock River Water Reclamation District and is effective. PASSED this 25th day of June, 2018.
